Farm Camp Overview

Greener Partners Farm Camps give kids a chance to dig in and experience an organic farm and daily “farm to table” eating. During these week-long day camps, our campers see first-hand where their food comes from as they learn to grow fruits and vegetables and prepare snacks using produce they have just harvested. Nature hikes, science-based projects, natural crafts, stories and games are also an important part of each fun-filled day.

Position Description

Junior Counselor Positions offer high school students an opportunity to gain hands-on experience working in a summer camp setting and on a community farm. JCs are an important member of the Farm Camp team, and help ensure that each day of camp is both exciting and safe.

Junior Counselors are volunteers who commit to assist with camp activities daily for a minimum of two weeks, and up to four weeks. Camps run from 9 am – 12 pm daily. Our dates for summer 2012 are:

July 2-6 (excluding July 4)
July 9-13
July 16-20
July 23-27

Responsibilities include:

- Support Camp Director and Counselors during camp activities, including farm activities such as harvesting and planting, arts and crafts, snack, and story time.
- Assist daily with set-up and clean up of camp space.
- Take a leadership role in daily activities such as story time, crafts, or cooking, depending on individual interest.

Many Junior Counselors use their summer camp experience to fulfill school and community service requirements, and we provide each Junior Counselor with a certificate detailing these hours at the completion of a session.
